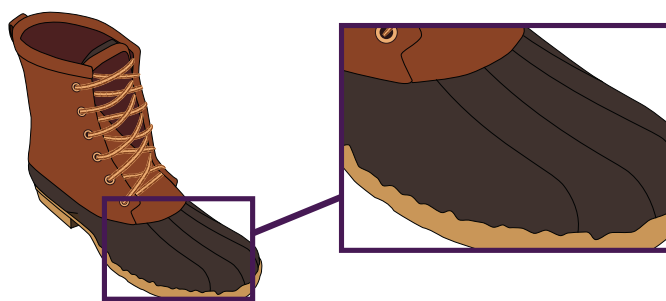
Bespoke Unit's Key Duck Boot Facts

- Invented in 1912 by Leon Leonwood Bean, essentially creating the company L.L. Bean
- A waterproof boot, it was originally made for hunting in muddy wooded areas



What Makes It A Duck Boot?

- A duck boot has a rubber sole with a leather boot shaft sewn to it and is totally waterproof
